

He Receives 2023 Lizhen Gui Award from CAPA

Lin (Jonathan) He, MD, PhD, was selected as one of two recipients of the *2023 Lizhen Gui Award* from the Chinese American Pathologist Association.

Evaluation for this pathologist-in training award is based on clinical performance, research/ publications during training, and leadership and service to CAPA and other pathology organizations. Award committee members independently review and score applications. In order to avoid conflict of interest, committee members do not score applications from the same institutions.



Dr. Lin (Jonathan) He is currently a PGY-4 AP&CP resident in training at the Department of pathology, University Texas (UT) Southwestern Medical Center. He has been consistently performing near the top of his residency class. He was elected unanimously by the faculties and his resident peers as co-chief resident. Dr. He has published 11 papers in peer-reviewed journals during residency including eight first-author publications. He was awarded the Bruce D. Fallis Resident Teaching Award and the Arthur G. Weinberg Resident Research Award from the Department of Pathology at UT Southwestern in May 2022. Dr. He has been an associate member of CAPA since 2019 and a member of the CAPA trainee committee and Online Education Committee (OLE). Dr. He

is well-known to audiences, organizers, and lectures of CAPA OLE lectures. He has been actively involved in coordinating course speakers and hosts, making weekly course flyer, and keeping a number of CAPA WeChat groups informed of the course schedule. His excellent contribution to CAPA community earned him the CAPA Service Award in March 2022.
