English as a Second Language (ESL) Courses

Want to improve your English skills? The Office of International Affairs at UT Southwestern offers the following classes:

Listening/Speaking	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Develop your ability to understand what you hear in English.</li> <li>• Practice speaking and increase your vocabulary.</li> <li>• Practice your conversational English and build your confidence for talking to native speakers all while you learn more about American culture.</li> </ul>
Advanced Grammar	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Develop a strong understanding of the grammatical structures common to American English.</li> <li>• Learn to apply one's knowledge of American English grammar in both written and oral performance.</li> <li>• Gain essential practice for all covered material through classroom activities and presentations.</li> </ul>
Presentation Skills	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Practice giving different types of presentations and responding to questions.</li> <li>• Practice proper stance and delivery of information to different audiences.</li> </ul>
Pronunciation and Accent Reduction 1 & 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This course focuses on the pronunciation of American English. Topics of study:</li> <li>• Consonant and vowel sounds of English, stress, rhythm, and intonation.</li> <li>• Patterns of words and phrases; patterns affecting speech such as deletions, insertions, and linking.</li> <li>• Differences between spelling and speech. Students will practice speaking using a variety of techniques to add speech patterns reflective of American English. Students will also learn how to evaluate their speech to become more competent and self-assured speakers.</li> </ul>
