It's important to realize that neither we nor our program are perfect. It's fine to be honest about your experience. Applicants want to know what it's like to train here. You've had plenty of highs and the lows by now. I also know that there is no parallel journey that you can compare this one to. But I hope you have realized by now what a marvelous experience it is to train at UTSW. I also hope you feel psychologically safe here. That you can speak up. That you have a voice and that what you feel matters. And that we are responsive to your needs big and small.

If applicants can sense your genuine self, when they know that what you are saying is authentic, they will relate to you and find themselves in you. It's not the metrics that count, it's the chemistry. You have the rizz. You are what I am most proud of. You are what makes this program great.
