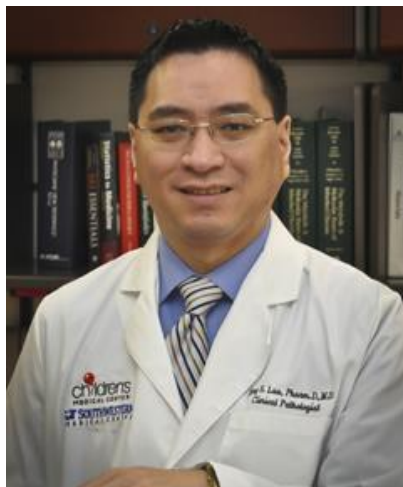


Dr. Hung Luu Reappointed to Health Information Technology Advisory Committee (HITAC)

The Government Accountability Office has reappointed Dr. Hung S. Luu to a second three-year term on the Health Information Technology Advisory Committee (HITAC), a federal advisory committee that makes recommendations to the Department of Health and Human Services Assistant Secretary for Technology Policy and National Coordinator for Health IT to address health information technology challenges.



Hung S. Luu, PharmD, MD, FCAP is the Director of Clinical Pathology at Children’s Health. He is Associate Professor of Pathology at UT Southwestern Medical Center. Dr. Luu received his pathology residency training at Cedars-Sinai Medical Center in Los Angeles, California, and completed a fellowship in hematopathology at City of Hope in Duarte, California. He has board certification in anatomic and clinical pathology, hematopathology, and clinical informatics.

Dr. Luu is an active member of the College of American Pathologist and is the incoming Chair of the Clinical Informatics Committee. He serves on the steering committee for the Food and Drug Administration’s SHIELD Community, a multi-stakeholder initiative to improve the quality, interoperability, and portability of laboratory data. Dr. Luu was previously appointed to a three-year term on the Health Information Technology Advisory Council (HITAC) in 2022 and was also appointed to the Clinical Laboratory Improvement Advisory Committee (CLIA) in 2023.
