The College of American Pathologists (CAP) Board of Governors has selected Hung S. Luu, M.D., as the Chair of the CAP Informatics Committee starting in 2025. Dr. Luu will lead the Clinical Informatics Committee to monitor, develop, and promote best practices in health IT and information science as applied to pathology practice.

About Dr. Luu

Hung S. Luu, PharmD, MD, FCAP is the Director of Clinical Pathology at Children's Health. He is Associate Professor of Pathology at UT Southwestern Medical Center. Dr. Luu received his pathology residency training at Cedars-Sinai Medical Center in Los Angeles, California, and completed a fellowship in hematopathology at City of Hope in Duarte, California. He has board certification in anatomic and clinical pathology, hematopathology, and clinical informatics.

Dr. Luu is an active member of the College of American Pathologist and serves on the Clinical Informatics Committee. He serves on the steering committee for the Food and Drug Administration's SHIELD Community, a multi-stakeholder initiative to improve the quality, interoperability, and portability of laboratory data. Dr. Luu was appointed to a three-year term on the Health Information Technology Advisory Council (HITAC) in 2022 and was also appointed to the Clinical Laboratory Improvement Advisory Committee (CLIAC) in 2023.
