Specific Aims	Specific Aims – Identify what you intend to accomplish and the hypothesis

Research Outline	The research proposal must be focused with clear aims which upon
	successful completion will add to both your research field and the
	advancement of clinical research at UT Southwestern. The applicant shall
	describe (in no more than three (3) pages) a project that develops new
	information in the field. The project outline should include the area of
	interest, details of the project, a two-year project timeline, discussion of how
	the project will add to the knowledge base of the field, and description of
	the applicant's time to be committed to the project.
Mentorship Team/Plan	Outline your current mentorship team and their contributions to your

	strategies you will employ to create an effective support system. Limit your
	summary to one (1) page.
Further Educational	Outline any further educational plans you have (if any). These may include
