

The LEAD Program



- Annual leadership development program, launched in 2013
- Designed for jr. faculty who aspire to develop their leadership skills
- Annual cohort of ~36 faculty
 - Assistant Professors (at least three years in rank)
 - Program components include:
 - 10 monthly topic-specific modules
 - Didactic lectures, case studies, and experiential activities
 - Mentoring and 1:1 Executive Coaching
 - Self-assessments
