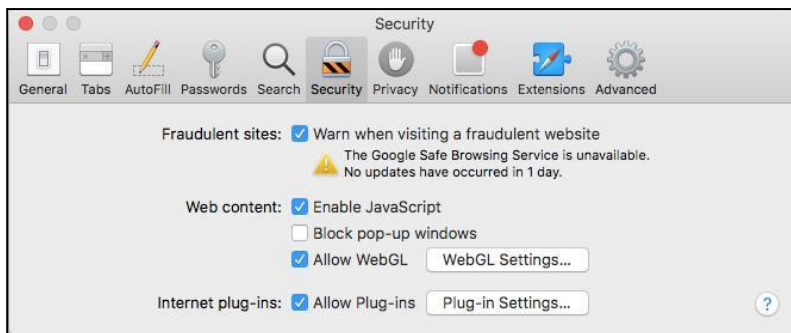
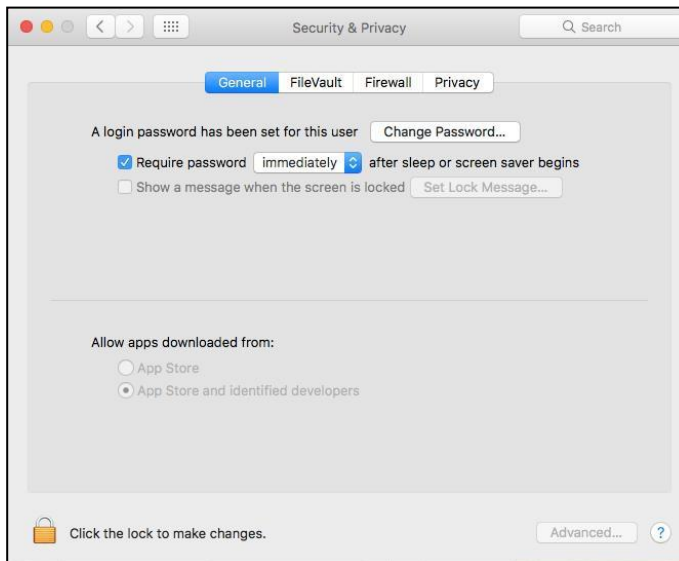
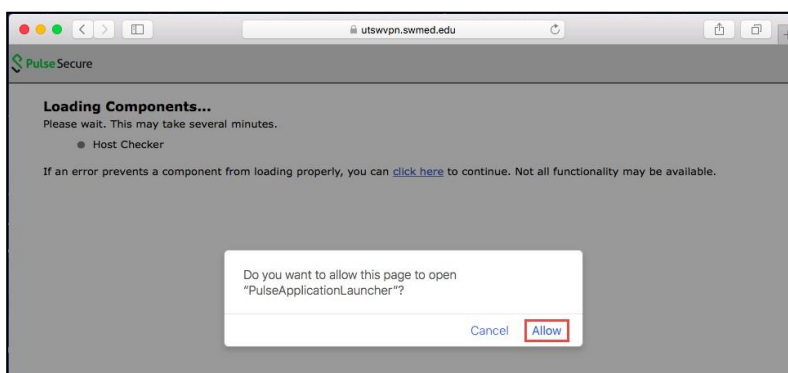


Installing Pulse Secure on a Mac Computer

1. Before installing Pulse Secure on your Mac, ensure that your settings match those shown here.



2. Once you are ready to install Pulse Secure, go to utswvpn.swmed.edu.
3. Click **Allow** to continue.



4. You will see a Pulse Connect Secure login page. Enter the following information:

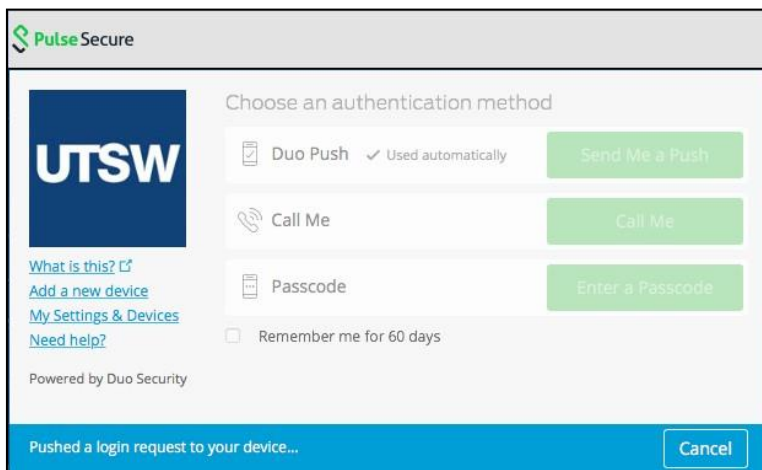

Password: SWID Password

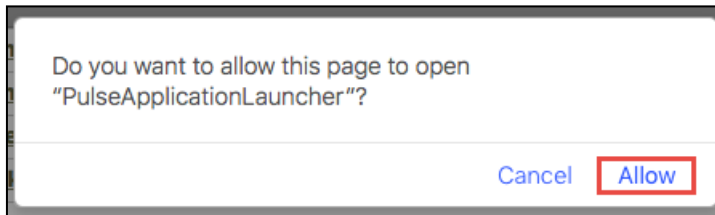
5. Press **Sign In**.



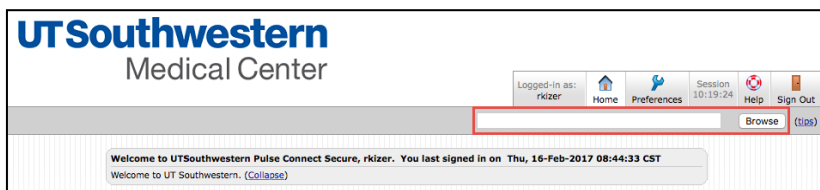
6. Choose your Two-Factor Authentication method and follow the prompts.



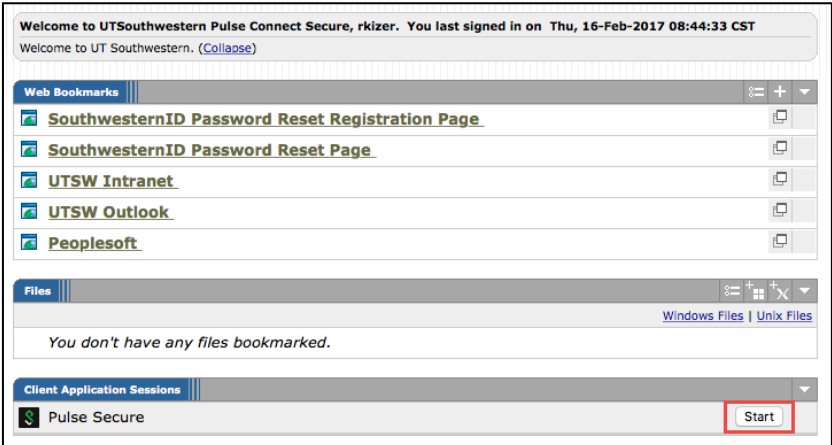
7. Press **Allow** to continue.



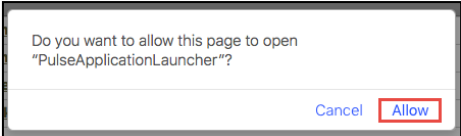
8. You are now connected to the Pulse Connect Secure web portal. From here, you can access any web site by typing the URL in the field below your username in the upper right-hand corner.



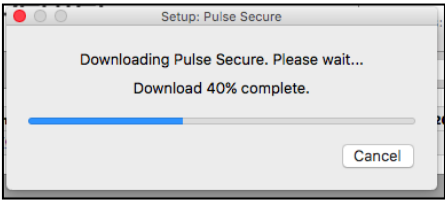
9. If this fits your needs, you can stop here. If you need the full VPN client, select **Start** next to Pulse Secure to install the client and continue to **Step 10**.



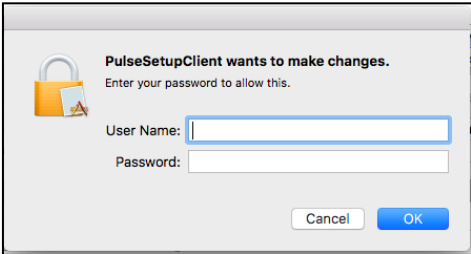
10. Press **Allow** to start the installation and the client will begin to download.



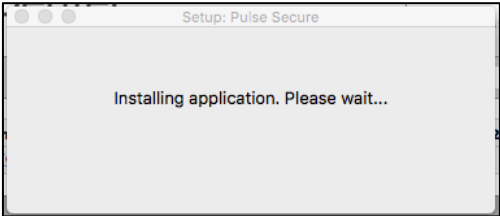
11. Enter your Macbook admin account username and password.



12. Press **OK**.

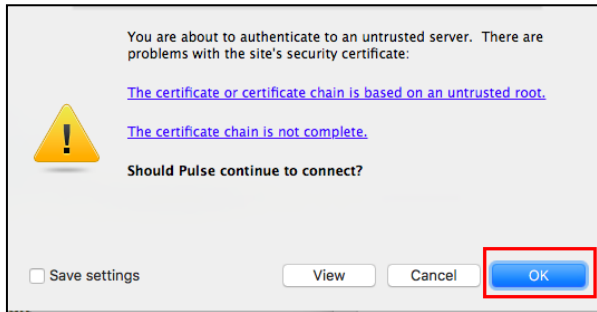


13. The client will start to install.

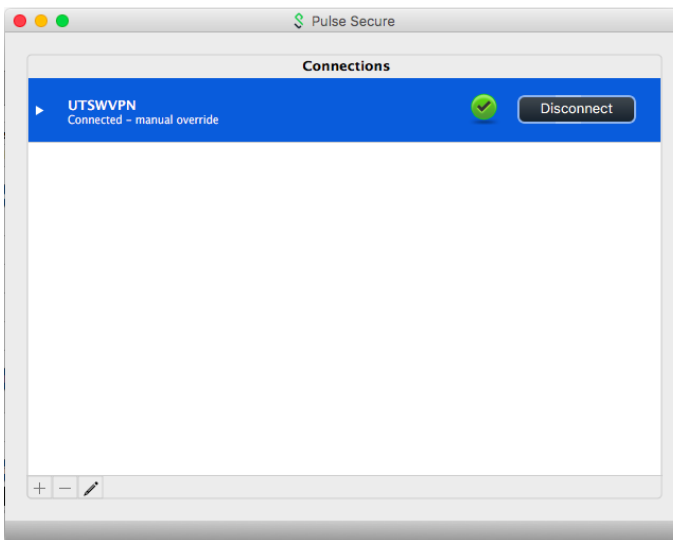


14. You will see a warning that says “You are about to authenticate to an untrusted server”. Press **OK** to continue.

Note: Pressing **View** or **Cancel** will corrupt the installation. If this happens, you will need to uninstall and reinstall the client for it work properly.



15. Client will show up as **Connected** once installed.



16. You can now use the Pulse Secure icon to connect and disconnect to the VPN client.
