**1 7A High Risk** – This is the 36-bed inpatient, high-risk pregnancy unit at Parkland Memorial Hospital. The fellow is expected to round on the antepartum service with the residents and run the weekly antepartum conference.

- 2 L&D/ECU Labor & Delivery and the Extended Care Unit at Parkland Memorial Hospital. The fellow is expected to be a resource to the upper level residents in the management of the highest acuity patients on the labor floor. One weekly night of call is required.
- 3 University Practice The fellows will perform outpatient consultations on complex maternal care patients, as well as enhance their ultrasound diagnostic skills at the UT Southwestern MFM clinics at both main campus (Dallas) and Plano locations.
- 4 Medical Intensive Care Unit (MICU) required rotation at Parkland Memorial Hospital.
