Keynote address by: Diane B. Wayne, M.D.

**Diane B. Wayne, M.D.**, is Vice Dean for Education, the Dr. John Sherman Appleman Professor of Medicine at Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine, Chair of the Department of Medical Education, and President of the McGaw Medical Center of Northwestern University. Dr. Wayne's research focuses on the intersection of education and patient care quality with expertise in simulation-based research. Her team has shown that high-quality education leads to improved clinical skills, reduced iatrogenic complications, and lower hospital costs than traditional approaches. She has published extensively in *Academic Medicine*, the *American Journal of Medical Quality*, the *Archives of Internal Medicine, Critical Care Medicine*, and *CHEST*.
