



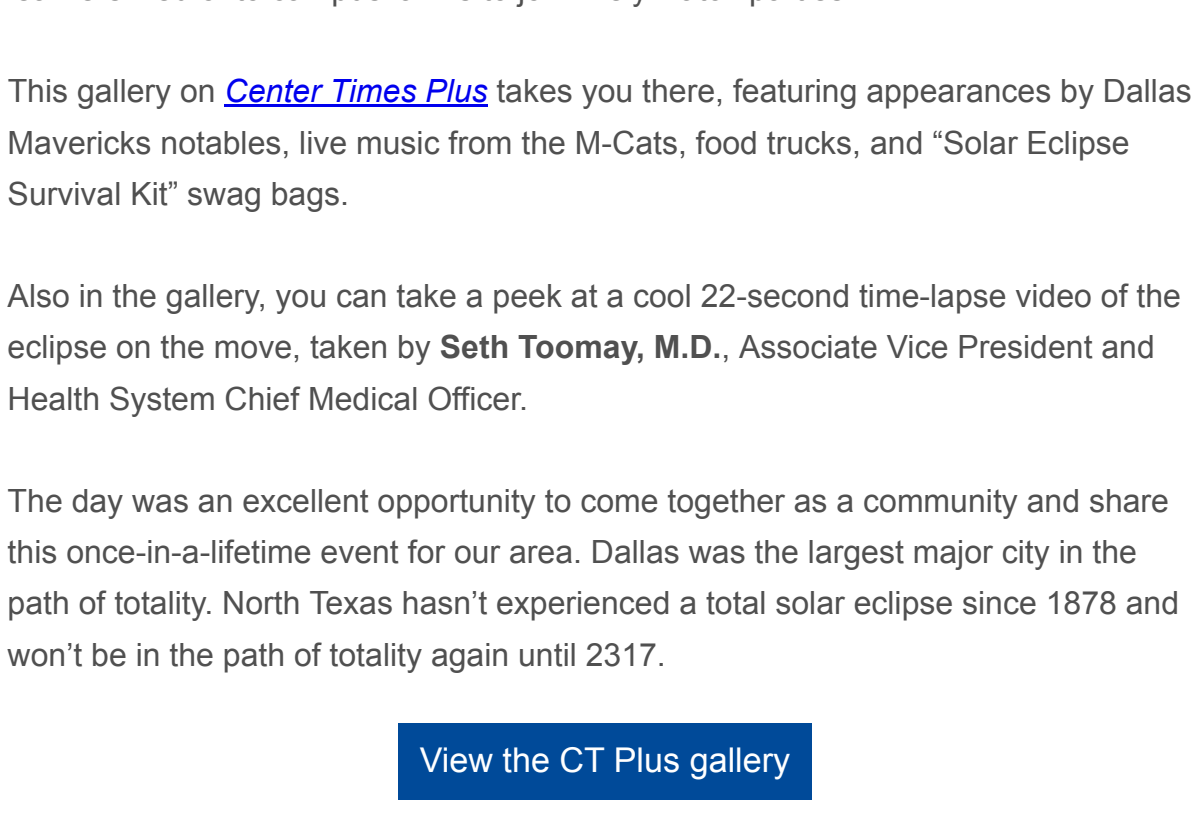
Call for abstracts: AI Symposium in Health Care

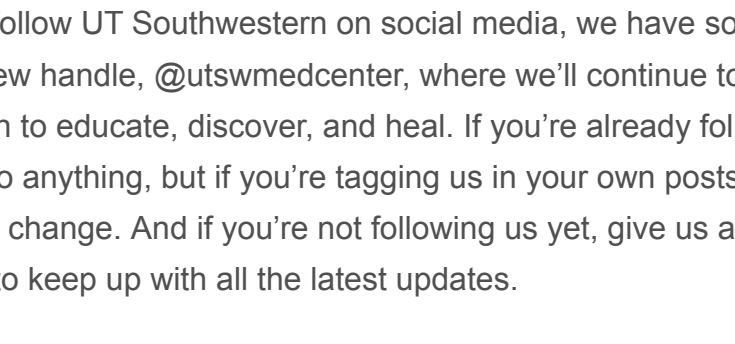


Mandatory compliance training due April 17

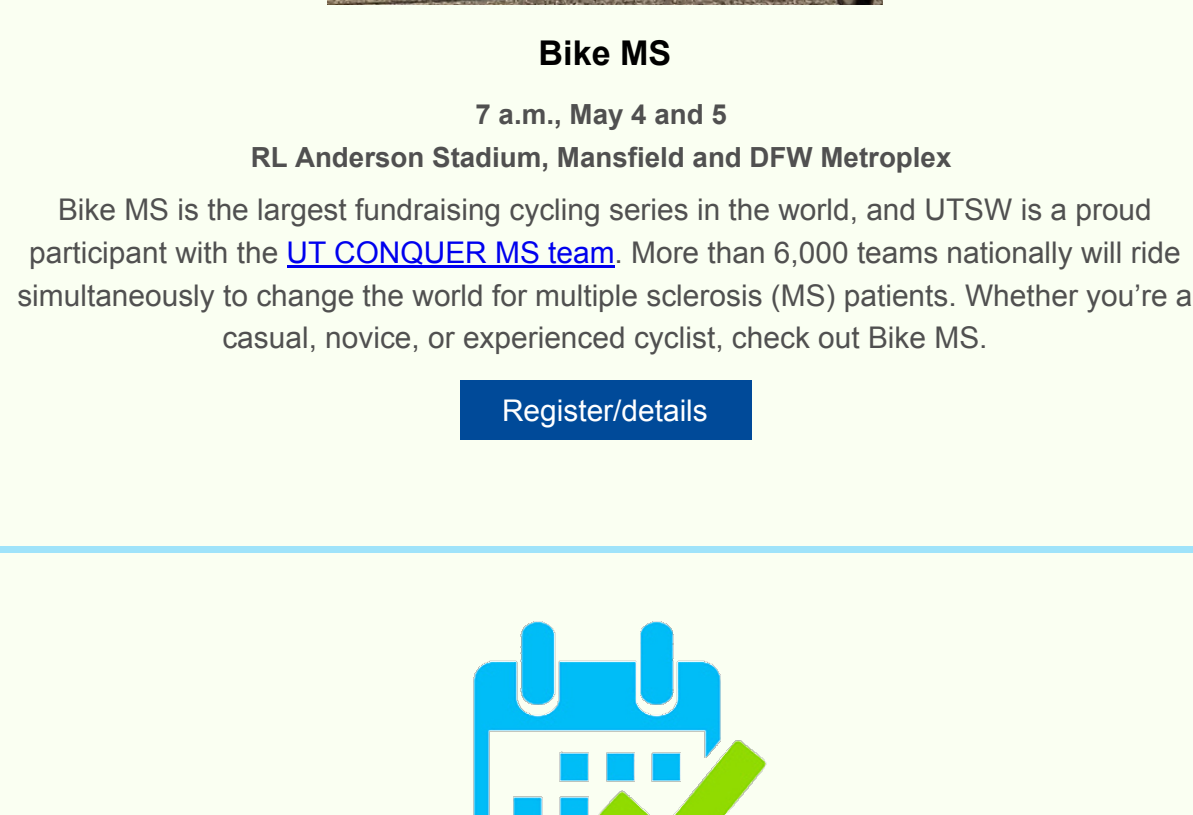
Get funding, connections to investors from Milestone Award

UT Southwestern faculty have until May 31 to apply for the [Biotech+ at Pegasus Park Commercialization Milestone Award](#). The most compelling technologies, as judged by a panel of investors, entrepreneurs, and industry partners, will receive up to \$100,000 in grant funding. Finalists will be announced June 14, and winners will be revealed July 1.

Sponsored by UTSW's Office for Technology Development, the competition was created to accelerate commercialization of our institution's technologies and increase licensing opportunities. 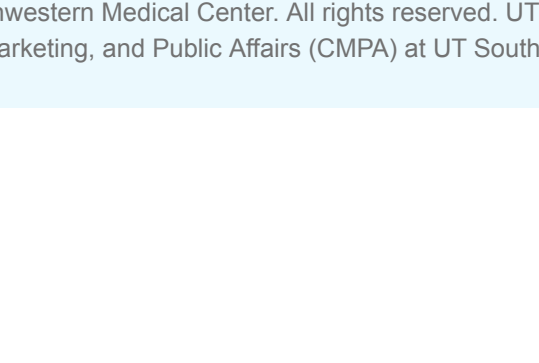
