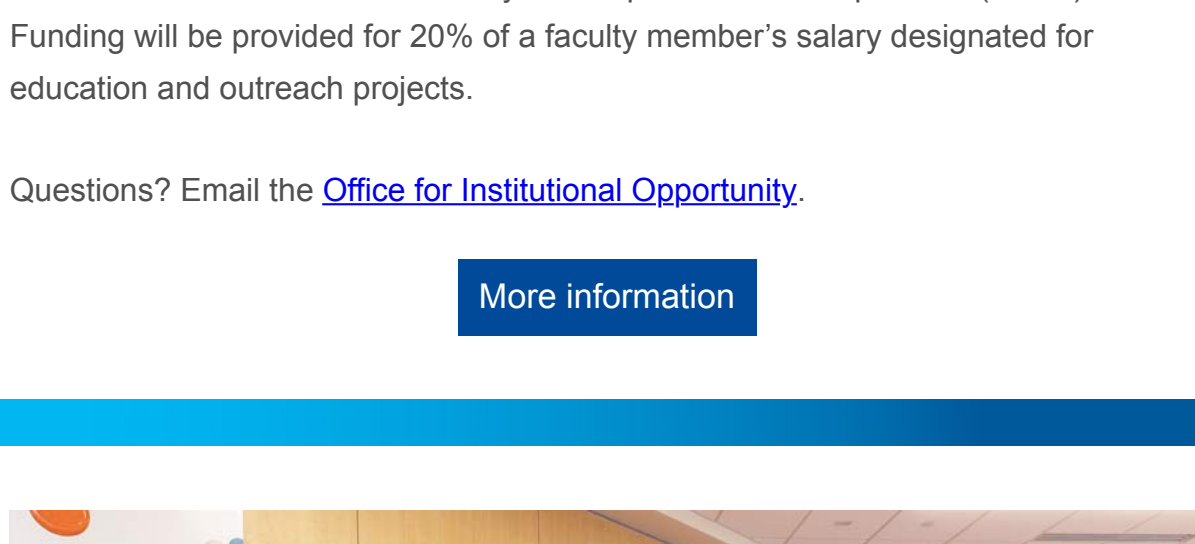


## WED PRESIDENT'S CAMPUS BRIEFING

### Health Equity Scholar Program nomination deadline is June 28

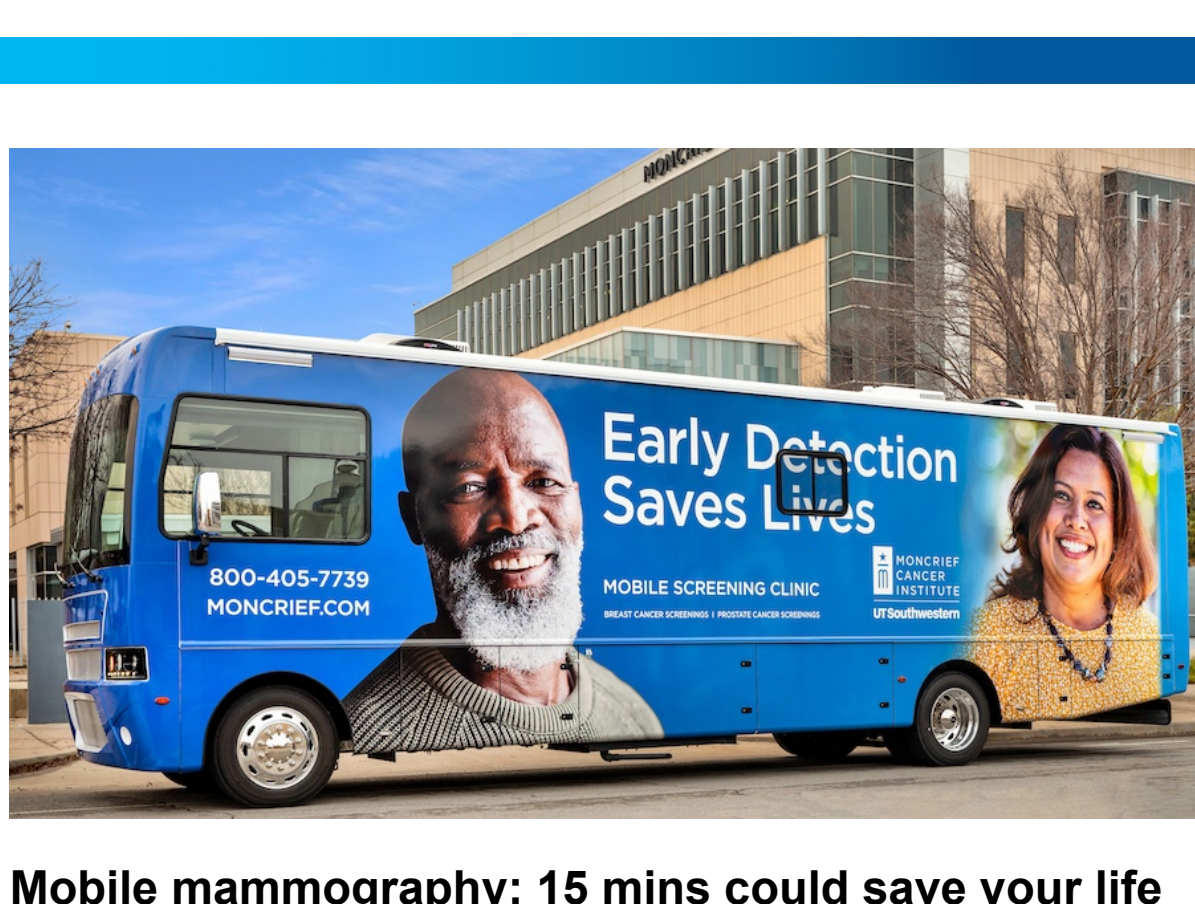
The Office for Institutional Opportunity has announced that the Health Equity Scholar Program, funded by UT Southwestern and Parkland Health, will be accepting nominations through June 28 for the October 2024 program.

This program was designed to recruit, develop, and retain faculty with an interest in health equity. Additionally, through improved clinical practice and research, it supports initiatives intended to advance better community health.

Each of the five scholars accepted will receive financial support and professional mentorship for two years, tools and experience to engage the community in activities that promote health and wellness, and an invitation to participate in UT Southwestern's Office of Faculty Development leadership cohort (LEAD). Funding will be provided for 20% of a faculty member's salary designated for education and outreach projects.
