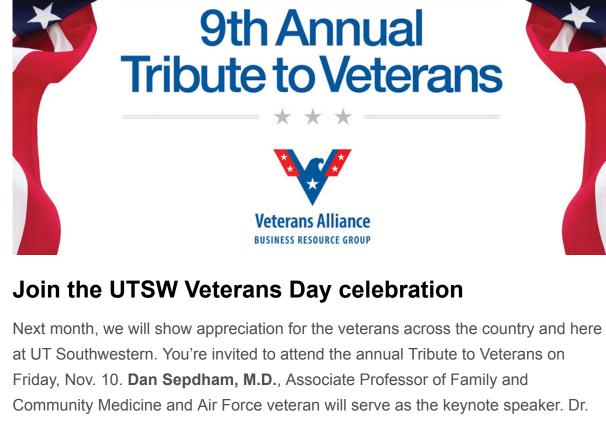
2023 class of the Leaders in Clinical Excellence. This deeper dive outlines how their achievements, contributions, and compassion led them to be selected as this year's award recipients.

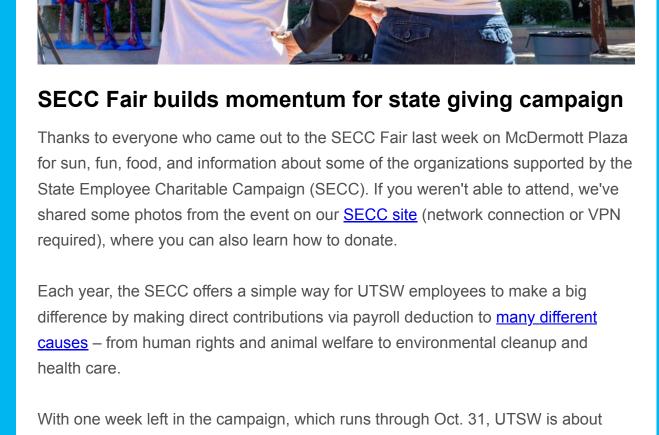
