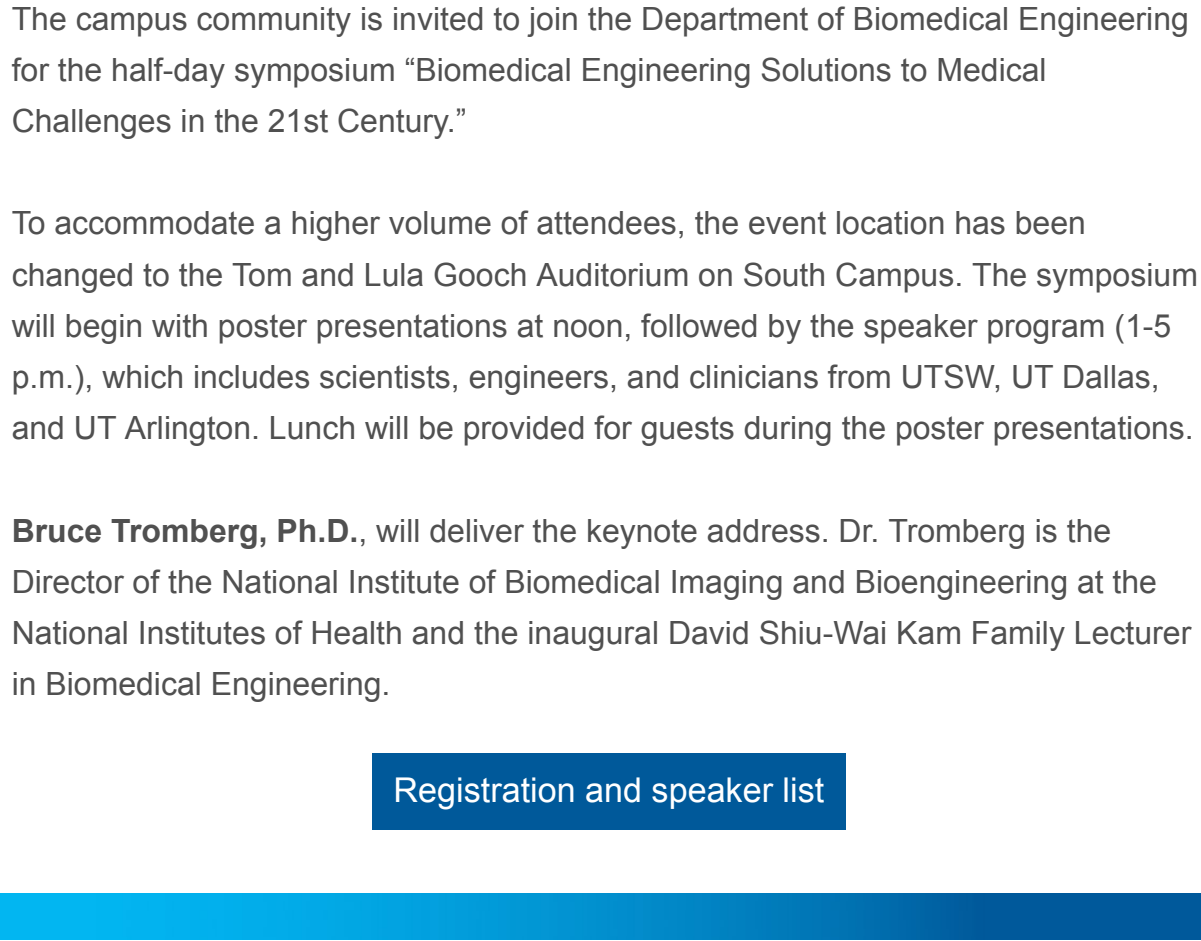


### Zale Lipsky entrance will temporarily relocate

Beginning Saturday, Dec. 9, the main entrance of Zale Lipsky Pavilion (ZLP) and valet services will move to the Charles Sprague breezeway off Lofland Boulevard. The temporary move is part of an ongoing renovation project at the hospital.

The change will be in effect through fall 2024 as we update building infrastructure, enhance surgical suites, improve dining areas, and expand restorative spaces for acute and rehabilitation services.

### New venue for Biomedical Engineering symposium

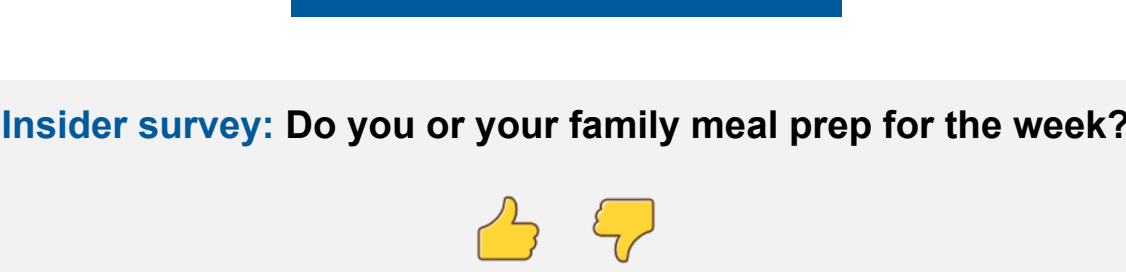

### Earn points during 'Well-Being Week,' maybe win a prize!

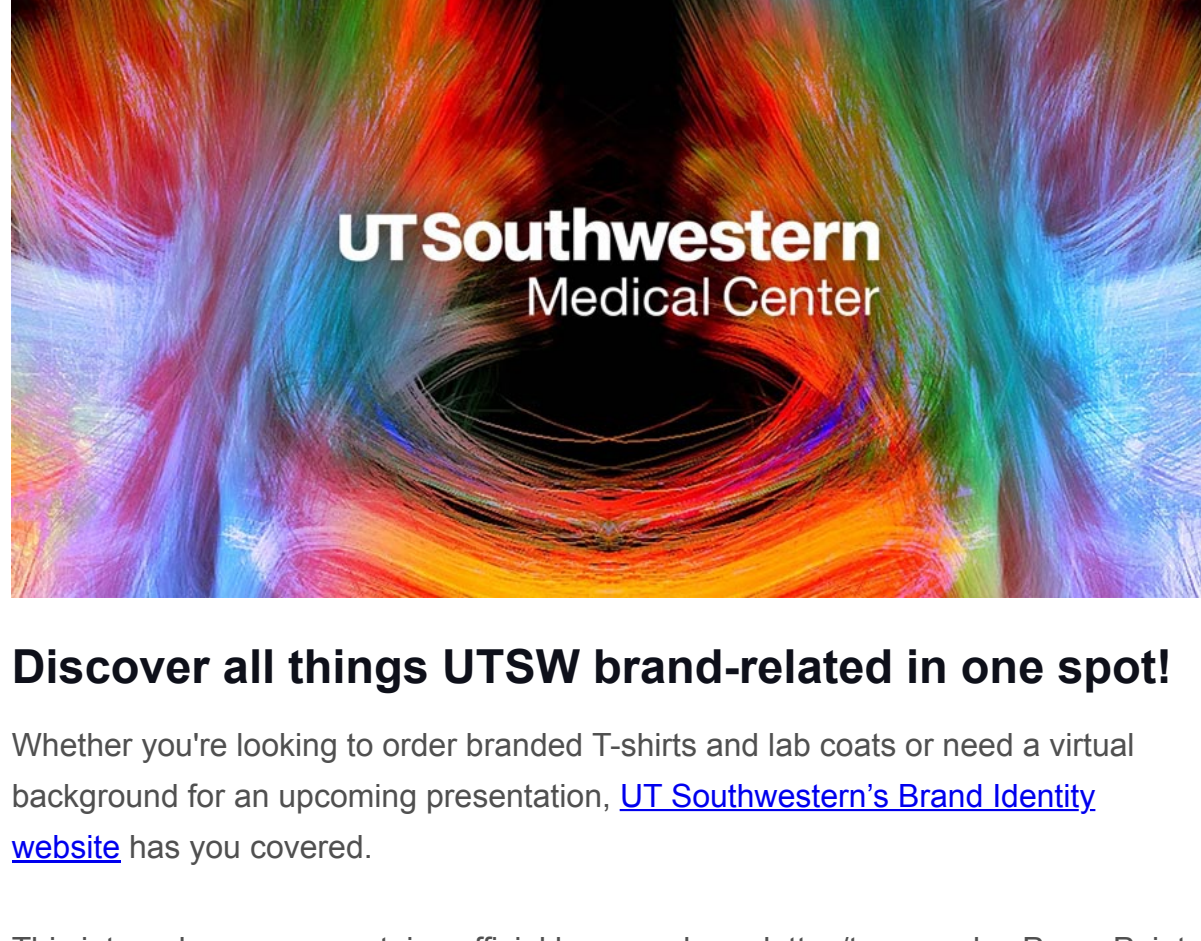
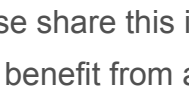

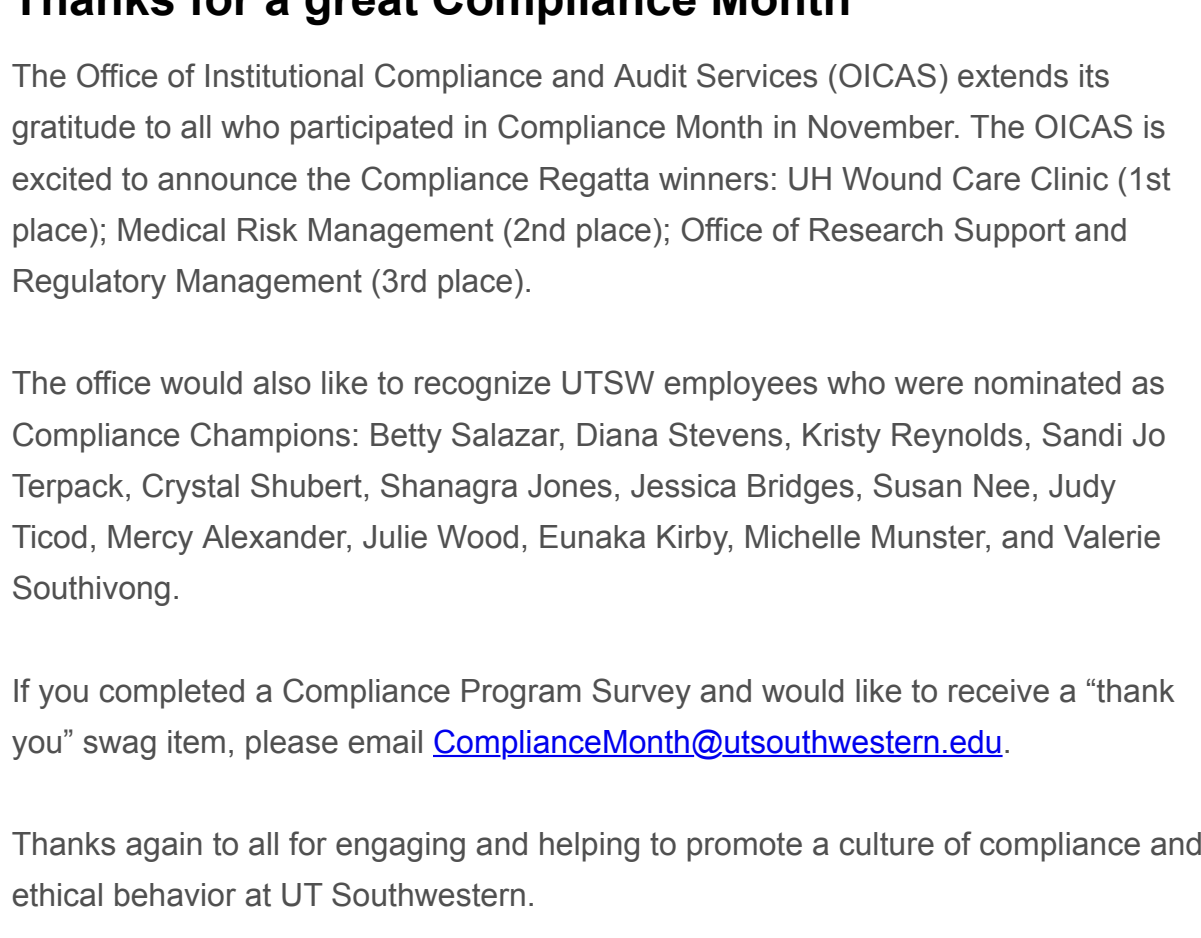


### Save the date: Cancer and heart-health screenings

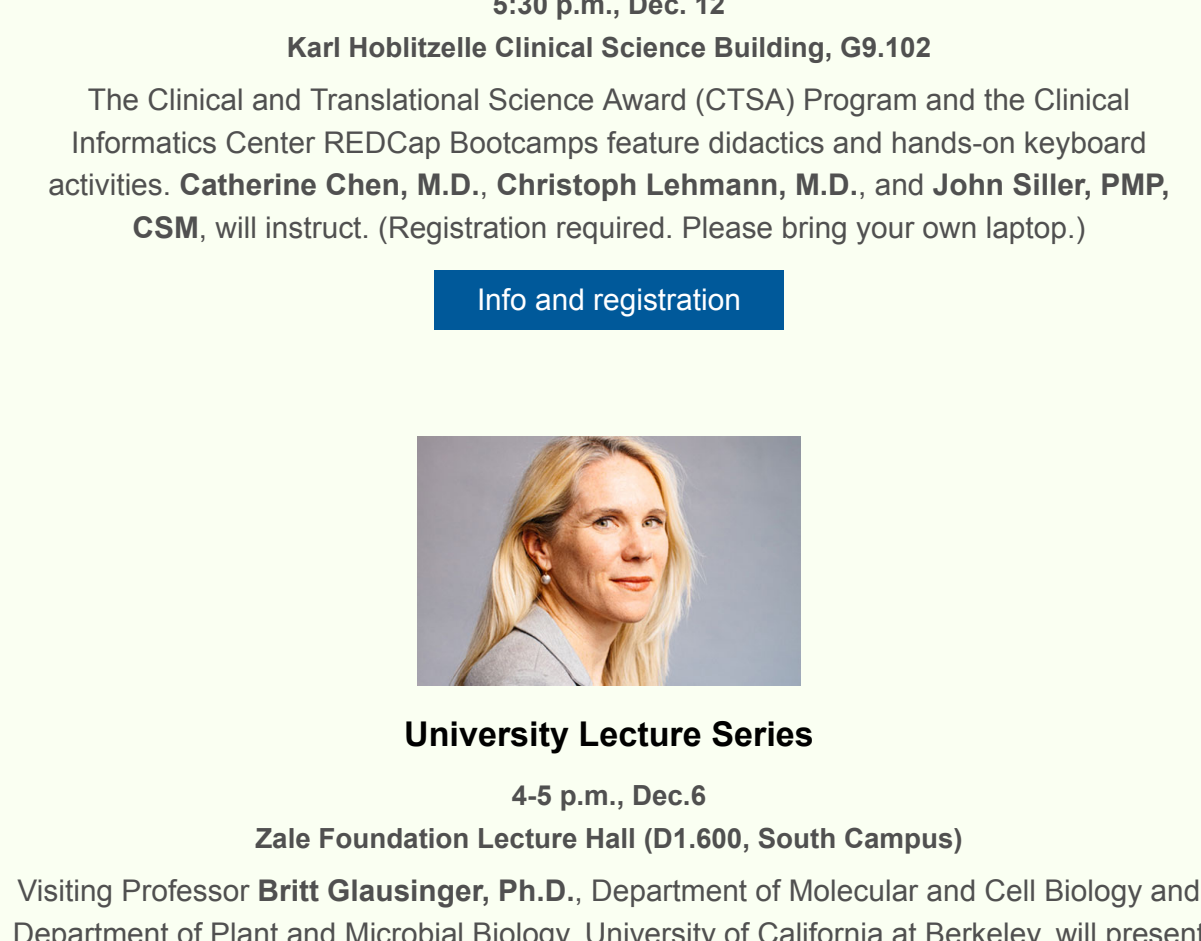

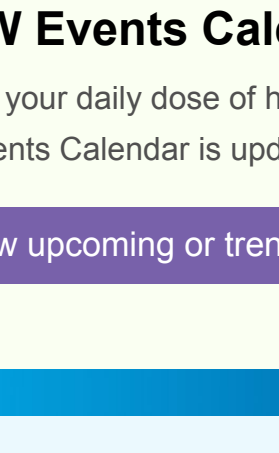
#### University Lecture Series
