


- - Do not hang decorations from/near the ceiling. Battery-operated lighting is required for hospital locations.
 - Artificial trees must meet the decoration fire code requirements. • Live trees or branches are prohibited.
 - Check lights for damaged wires, broken light bulbs, or garland that sheds, and discard any damaged items. Use a stepladder (never chairs or desks) to stand on while hanging
 - Follow the instructions and warnings on decoration labels.




