belzutifan to treat metastatic kidney cancer marks a milestone for UT Southwestern. A series of scientific discoveries starting in the 1990s, followed by years of research here, paved the way for this first-in-class drug to treat one of the most common

types of kidney cancer. In 2010, a team from UTSW established Peloton Therapeutics, which developed the drug. Peloton was later acquired by pharmaceutical giant Merck. "This remarkable journey exemplifies UT Southwestern's dedication to converting important scientific discoveries into improvements in patient care and underscores the power of innovation and team science in advancing health care," said James Brugarolas, M.D., Ph.D., Professor of Internal Medicine in the Division of Hematology and Oncology and founding Director of the Kidney Cancer Program at


